

## Hello Neighbor!

We have learned of a proposed extended stay, mid-market hotel development to be constructed in the small parcel immediately south of LUMA, at 1130 S. Hope St. This project will be a 175 'tall, 61,000+ square foot hotel with automated parking. The hotel would provide a blank wall just 20 'away facing all of our southern units, with an outdoor rooftop lounge for hotel guests. The hotel guests, employees and service vehicles would share our alley access. A loading dock is proposed where our trash trucks and moving trucks currently load and unload.

The LUMA Board opposes this project on the grounds that it is incompatible with the vision for the South Park neighborhood and its erosive impact on our quality of life. An attorney has been hired to assist us in our efforts. Please review the attached materials for additional information.

We are seeking 100 signatures from LUMA, ELLEVEN and EVO residents and owners on the attached petition to our Councilmember to request that the developer be required to complete a full Environmental Impact Report (EIR). This will allow us to perform further due diligence and delay the approval process in order to make our case to city officials
